Installation/ Uninstallation

Install the Software

The software can be installed in a few easy-to-follow steps and takes only a few minutes. To install the software, you need to have the installer in place. If you don't have the installer, then you can download the same from our website: <u>https://www.nucleustechnologies.com/sql-migration/</u>

Once you have the installer file, you can execute the following steps to install the software:

- Double click on the Kernel Migrator for SQL Server Installer file.
- Follow the onscreen instructions. When the installation process completes "Installation Complete" message appears on the screen.
- Click on the Finish button to launch the software.

Uninstall the Software

The software is one of the safest to use and undergoes clean uninstallation which can be done in any of the following ways:

- Uninstalling from the Control Panel
- Uninstalling from Windows Start Menu

Uninstalling from the Control Panel

Execute the following steps to uninstall the application through Control Panel:

- Click Start -> Control Panel. The Control Panel window appears.
- Double-click the Add or Remove Programs icon. A list of the programs installed on your computer appears.
- Select Kernel Migrator for SQL Server and click the Remove button. A warning message before uninstalling the software will be displayed on the screen.
- Click the Yes button to un-install the software.

• Click the OK button.

This will uninstall the Kernel Migrator for SQL Server software from your system.

Uninstalling from Windows Start Menu

Execute the following steps to uninstall the software through Window Start Menu:

- Click Start > All Programs > Kernel Migrator for SQL Server> Uninstall Kernel Migrator for SQL Server.
 A warning message before uninstalling the software will be displayed on the screen.
- Click the Yes button to uninstall the software.
- Click the OK button.

This will uninstall the Kernel Migrator for SQL Server software from your system.
