Install Kernel for Digital Media

After checking your computer with the prescribed system requirements for Kernel for Digital Media, you can download and install the software on your computer.

After downloading the installer file for Kernel for Digital Media, you can install the software by running the file. To install Kernel for Digital Media:

1. Double-click the Kernel for Digital Media installer.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions.
The **Setup Installation Complete** screen will be displayed.
3. Click the **Finish** button to complete the installation.

Start Kernel for Digital Media

To start Kernel for Digital Media:

Click the **Start>All Programs>Kernel for Digital Media**

Alternatively, you can launch Kernel for Digital Media by double-clicking the shortcut icon available on the desktop and Quick Launch icon.

Uninstall Kernel for Digital Media

You may need to uninstall and re-install Kernel for Digital Media. To uninstall Kernel for Digital Media:

1. Click the **Start>All Programs>Kernel for Digital Media>Uninstall Kernel for Digital Media**. A warning message will be displayed.

2. Click **Yes** to uninstall Kernel for Digital Media.

Note: Before proceeding to uninstall Kernel for Digital Media, you must ensure that the software is not running.

You can alternatively uninstall Kernel for Digital Media from the **Control Panel** by performing the following steps:

1. Click the **Start Menu > Control Panel** and then double click the **Add or Remove Programs** icon.
2. Select **Kernel for Digital Media** and click **Remove**. A warning message will be displayed.
3. Click **Yes** to uninstall Kernel for Digital Media.
