Installation/Uninstallation Guide

### Install Kernel Outlook Recovery Tool

The installation process of the software involves a few easy steps. Before proceeding, make sure you have the setup file. If you don't have the setup, then go to the website and install it.

Once you get the installer file, follow the steps below to install the software accurately:

- ✓ Locate Kernel Outlook Recovery Tool installer file and double click on it.
- $\checkmark\,$  Next, follow the on-screen instructions.
- Once installation is done, a success message saying Setup Installation
  Complete appears on screen.
- $\checkmark\,$  Click on the Finish button to launch the software.

After successfully completing the installation process, a software shortcut will be added to the **Windows Start Program** menu. You can either launch the software from the Program Menu or create a desktop icon to directly launch it.

## Uninstall Kernel Outlook Recovery Tool

You can uninstall Kernel Outlook Recovery from your system with two methods listed below:

- ✓ From the Windows Start menu
- ✓ From the Control Panel



## Uninstall from the Windows Start Menu

- ✓ Click on the **Start** menu and go to **All Programs**.
- ✓ Click on Kernel Outlook Recovery » Uninstall Kernel Outlook Recovery.
- ✓ You will get a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- ✓ Click on **Yes** to uninstall the software.

#### Uninstall from the Control Panel

- ✓ Click on the **Start** button, then **Control Panel**.
- ✓ Go to Programs and Features and look for Kernel Outlook Recovery.
- ✓ Right-click on Kernel Outlook Recovery and click on the Uninstall button.
- $\checkmark$  You will get a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- ✓ Click on **Yes** to uninstall the software.

Kernel Outlook Recovery will be successfully uninstalled from your computer system.
