



# Kernel Cloud Backup

## Installation/ Uninstallation

This guide provides information about the process of installing Kernel Cloud Backup. To ensure that you install the tool on your Windows OS in a correct way, follow this guide thoroughly.

### Install the Software

At this moment, you know everything regarding Kernel Cloud Backup tool, be it features and system requirements. Now, let's have a look at the process to install the software on your system. Before proceeding, make sure that you have software installer file on your device. If the software executable is not available on your system, then download the file from <https://www.nucleustechnologies.com/cloud-backup/>

After downloading the installer file of the Kernel Cloud Backup tool successfully, perform the given steps to install the software:

- Double-click on Kernel Cloud Backup installer file.
- Perform the step-by-step procedure as prompted on the screen.
- Once installation process gets completes “Completing the Kernel Cloud Backup Setup Wizard” message prompts on software installation screen.
- Click on the Finish button to finalize the software installation and then launch the software.

### Uninstall the Software

For uninstalling the Kernel Cloud Backup software from your device, you can utilize any of the following two methods:

- ✓ **Uninstall from Windows Start Menu**
- ✓ **Uninstall from Control Panel**

Note: Before executing the uninstallation process, make sure that the Kernel Cloud Backup software is not in use.

## Uninstall from the Windows Start menu

To uninstall Kernel Cloud Backup software from the Windows Start Menu, you can utilize the below outlined steps:

- Click on Start >All Programs > Kernel Cloud Backup >Uninstall Kernel Cloud Backup.
- You will receive a warning message on your system's screen before uninstalling the software.
- Click on the Yes button to uninstall the software.
- Click on the OK button.

Kernel Cloud Backup software is successfully uninstalled from your computer system.

## Uninstall from Control Panel

To uninstall Kernel Cloud Backup software from the Control Panel, you can utilize the below outlined steps:

- Click on Start >Control Panel. This will open the Control Panel wizard on your screen.
- Double-click on the Programs and Features icon. A list containing all programs installed on your software will appear on your screen.
- Select Kernel Cloud Backup and click Uninstall option.
- You will receive a warning message on your system's screen before uninstalling the software.
- Click on the Yes button to install the software.
- Click on the OK button.
