Install Kernel for Document Viewer

The installation process of the software involves a few easy steps. Before proceeding, make sure you have the setup file. If you don't have the setup, then go to the website and install it from:

<https://www.nucleustechnologies.com/document-viewer/>

Once you get the installer file, follow the steps below to install the software accurately:

- Locate **Kernel for Document Viewer installer** file and double click on it.
- Next, follow the on-screen instructions.
- Once installation is done, a success message saying '**Setup Installation Complete**' appears on the screen.
- Click on the **Finish** button to launch the software.

After installation, a software shortcut will be added to the Windows **Start Program** menu. You can launch the software from **Program Menu** or **create a desktop icon** to launch it directly.

Un-install Kernel for Document Viewer

You can uninstall Kernel for Document Viewer from your system with two methods listed below:

- **From the Windows Start menu**
- **From the Control Panel**

Un-install from the Windows Start menu

- Click on the **Start menu** and go to **All Programs**.
- Click on **Kernel for Document Viewer >Uninstall Kernel for Document Viewer**.

- You will receive a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- Click on **Yes** option to uninstall the software.
- Lastly, click on the **OK** button.

Kernel for Document Viewer has been successfully uninstalled from your computer system.

Un-install from the Control Panel

- Click on the **Start** button, then **Control Panel**.
- Go to **Programs and Features** and look for **Kernel for Document Viewer**.
- Right-click on **Kernel for Document Viewer** and click the **Uninstall** option.
- You will receive a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- Click on the **Yes** button to uninstall the software.

Kernel for Document Viewer is successfully uninstalled from your computer system.
