Install Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator

Uninstall from the Windows Start Menu

- ✓ Click on the **Start** menu and go to **All Programs**.
- ✓ Click on Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator » Uninstall Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator.
- ✓ You will get a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- ✓ Click on **Yes** to uninstall the software.

Uninstall from the Control Panel

- ✓ Click on the **Start** button, then **Control Panel**.
- ✓ Go to Programs and Features and look for Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator.
- ✓ Right-click on Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator and click on the Uninstall button.
- \checkmark You will get a warning message before uninstalling the software on the screen.
- ✓ Click on Yes to uninstall the software.

Kernel Office 365 to G Suite Migrator will be successfully uninstalled from your computer system.
