



## Kernel for **SCO Open Server** Installation/ Un-installation

### Install Kernel for SCO Open Server

After checking your computer with the prescribed system requirements for Kernel for SCO Open Server, you can download and install the software on your computer.

If you want to try using Kernel for SCO Open Server before buying it, you can download the evaluation version from the following link: <https://www.nucleustechnologies.com/download-sco-recovery-software.php>

After downloading the installer file for Kernel for SCO Open Server, you can install the software by running the file. To install Kernel for SCO Open Server:

1. Double-click the Kernel for SCO Open Server installer.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions.  
The **Setup Installation Complete** screen will be displayed.
3. Click the **Finish** button to complete the installation.

### Start Kernel for SCO Open Server

To start Kernel for SCO Open Server:

Click the **Start>All Programs>Kernel for SCO Open Server**

Alternatively, you can launch Kernel for SCO Open Server by double-clicking the shortcut icon available on the desktop and Quick Launch icon.

### Uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server

You may need to uninstall and re-install Kernel for SCO Open Server. To uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server:

1. Click the **Start>All Programs>Kernel for SCO Open Server>Uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server**. A warning message will be displayed.
2. Click **Yes** to uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server.

**Note:** Before proceeding to uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server, you must ensure that the software is not running.

You can alternatively uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server from the **Control Panel** by performing the following steps:

1. Click the **Start Menu>Control Panel** and then double click the **Add or Remove Programs** icon.
2. Select **Kernel for SCO Open Server** and click **Remove**. A warning message will be displayed.
3. Click **Yes** to uninstall Kernel for SCO Open Server.
