1. Introduction

Our software supports the migration in any environment supported by Microsoft itself. This document will confirm the various types of migration that Kernel Migrator for Exchange supports and which features will be included.

2. Supported Migration Types

2.1 Supported Intra-forest / Intra-domain (Same Domain) Migrations

The following migrations are supported between two Exchange Servers, which can coexist in the same domain or forest.

The solution supports Public Folder migration between two Exchange Servers (up to 2010) in the same domain. However, Public Folder permissions, limits and properties will not be migrated.

NOTE: The administrator has to create a different Public Folder hierarchy other than the default root in the target Exchange Server in order to migrate the Public Folders.

2.2 Supported Cross-Forest Migration Types

The following User Mailbox, Public Folder and Archive Mailbox migrations are supported between any two versions of Exchange.
