NOTE: Connecting to Office 365 as destination requires you to select a Global Administrator User Mailbox, which has full access to all mailboxes. You can connect to Office 365 and Archive Mailboxes through Outlook Profile only.

3. Install Kernel Migrator for SharePoint

You have to download the installer file of Kernel Migrator for SharePoint from <https://www.nucleustechologies.com/sharepoint-migration/>. Please make sure your computer meets the system requirements and user rights mentioned above for installing this software.

Perform the following steps to install Kernel Migrator for SharePoint.

1. Double-click the downloaded installer file to start the installation.

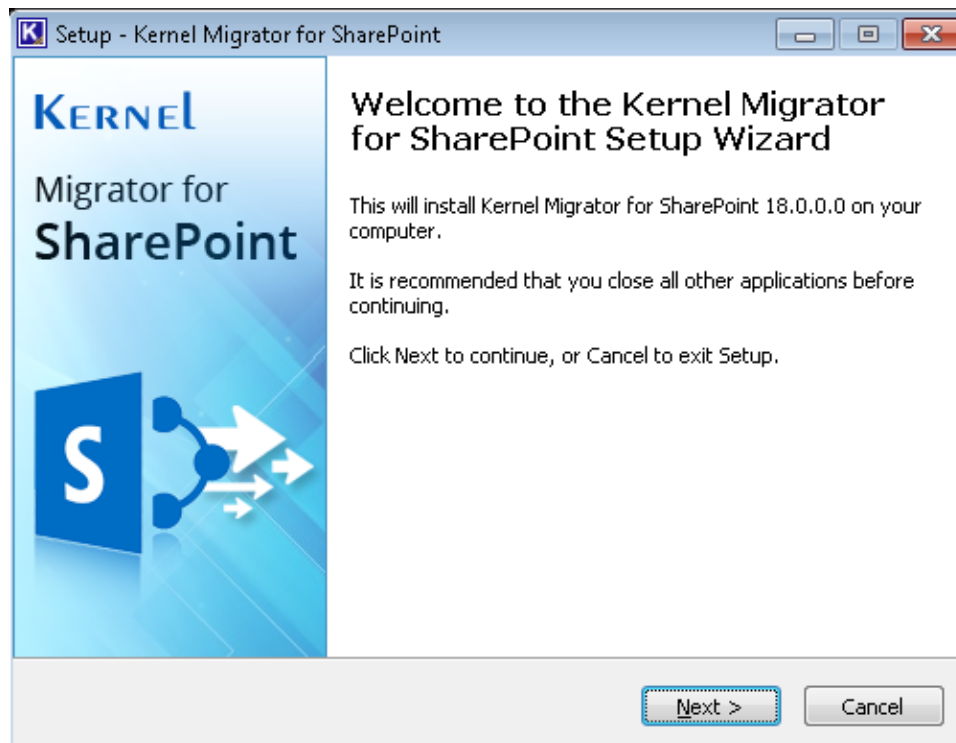


Figure 1: Starting the Installation

2. Click "Next" to proceed to the next step.

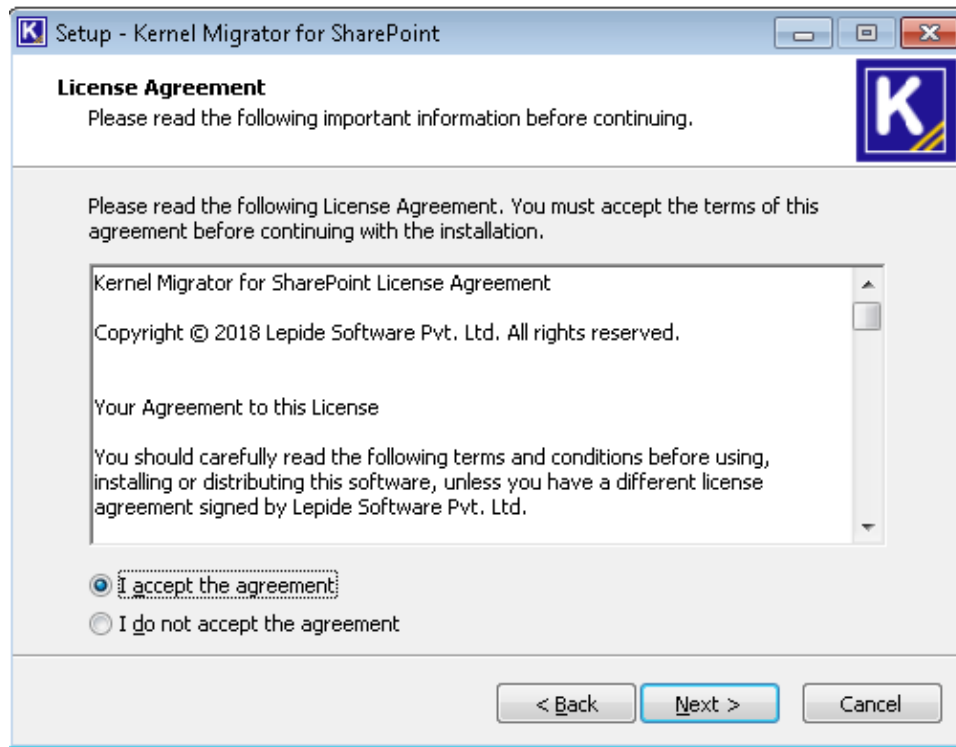


Figure 2: License Agreement

3. It is recommended to read the license agreement carefully before installing the software.
4. If you agree to the license agreement and want to continue the installation, then click "I accept the agreement" and click "Next".
5. The following screen appears which allows you to modify the destination. The default installation location is **%ProgramFiles%\Kernel Migrator for SharePoint** for both 32-bit and 64-bit Windows OS.

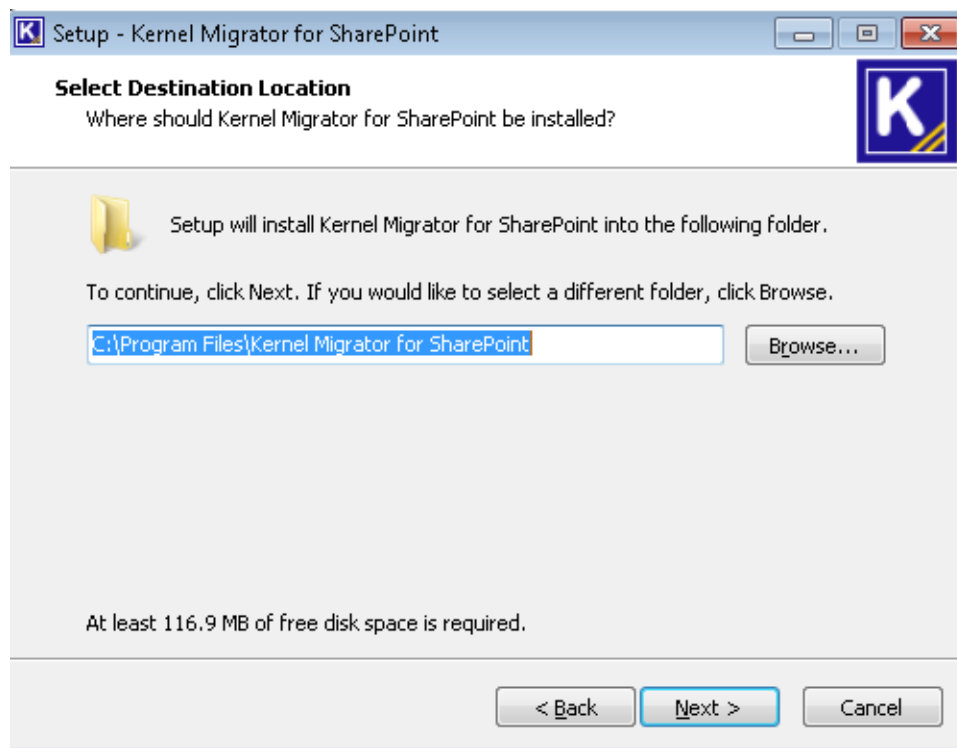


Figure 3: Change the Installation Location

6. If you want to modify the installation location, then click "Browse" and select the desired location.
7. Click "Next" to proceed further. Here, you can customize the location of the shortcuts folder in the Start Menu.

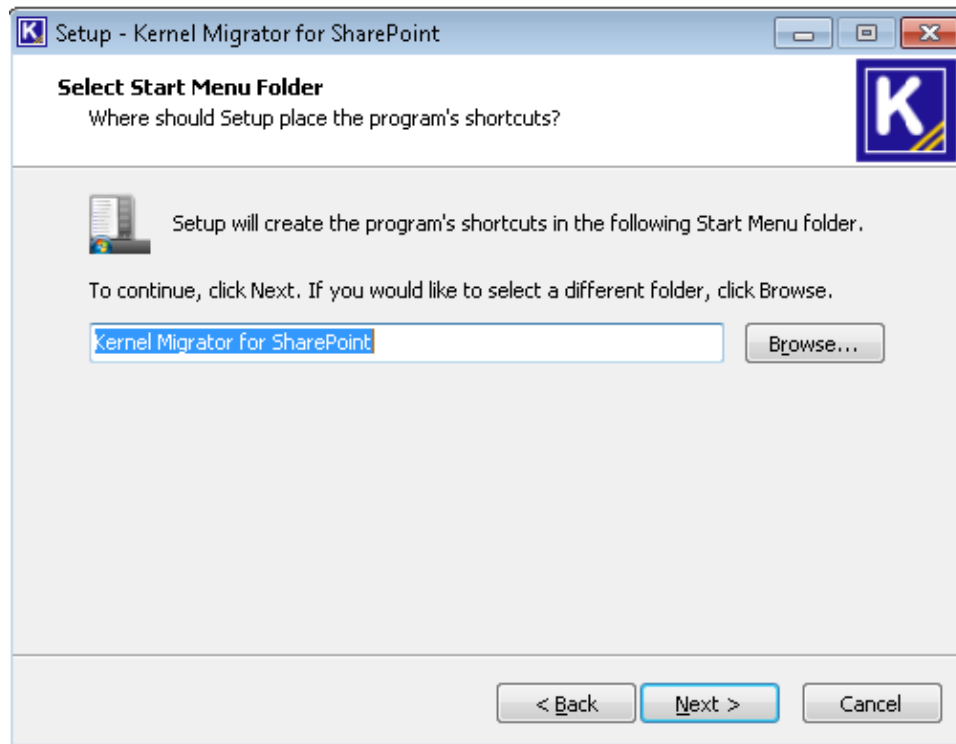


Figure 4: Option to modify the Shortcuts folder

8. Click "Browse" and select a different location to modify the location of the shortcuts folder in the Start Menu.
9. Click "Next" to use the default or customized shortcuts folder.
10. The next step displays the option to create the additional shortcuts.

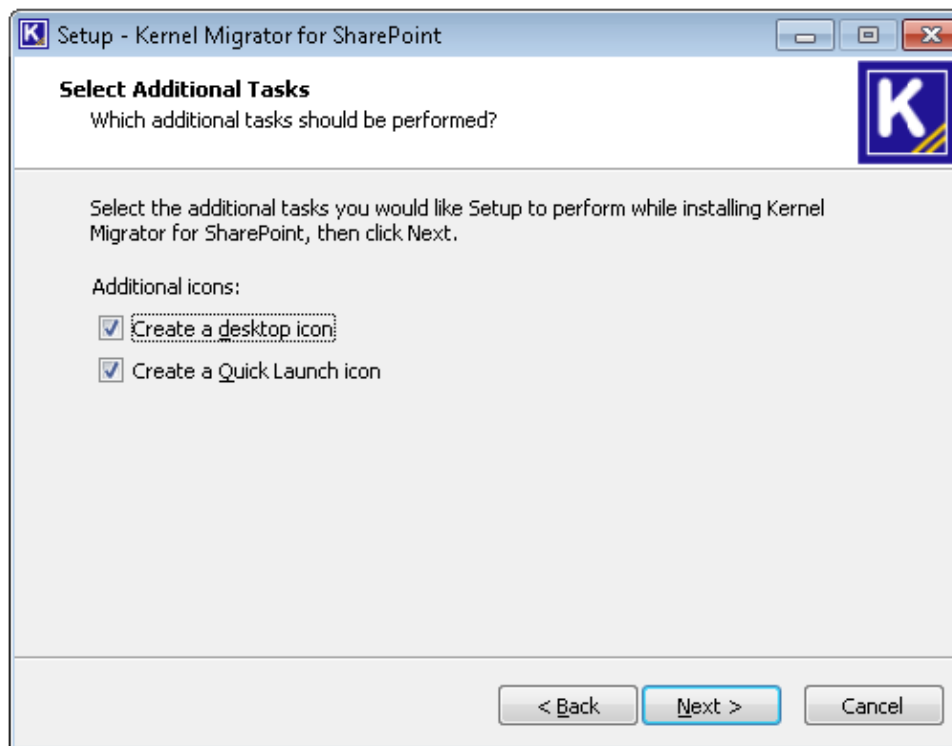


Figure 5: Perform Additional Tasks

11. Check the boxes titled "Create a desktop icon" and/or "Create a Quick Launch icon", if you want.
12. Click "Next" to proceed to the next step that shows setup is now ready to install.

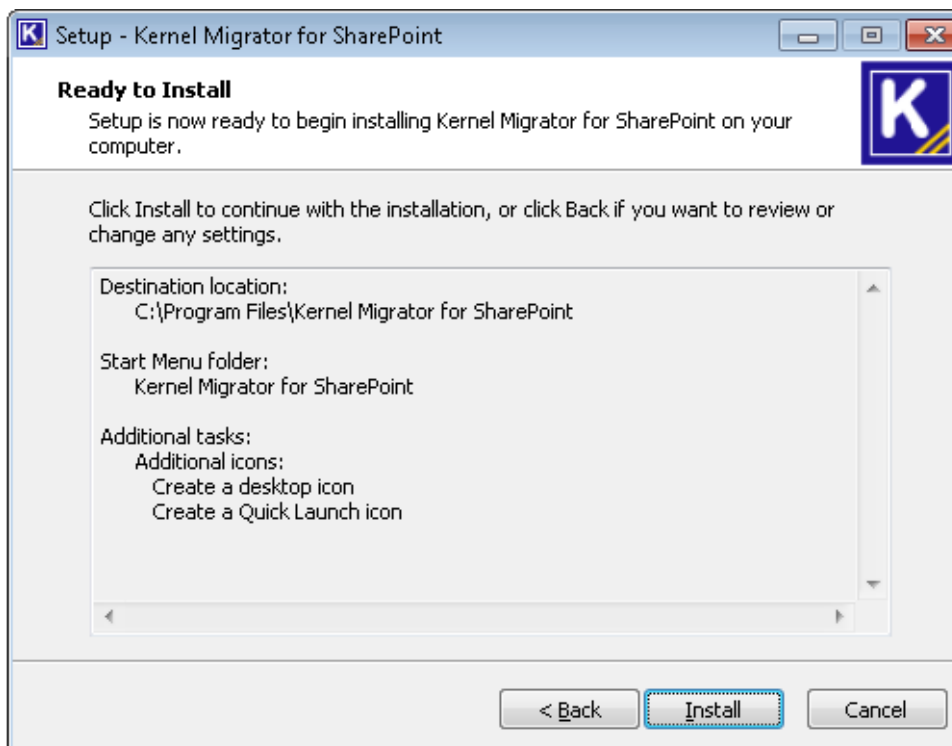


Figure 6: Software is now ready to install

13. Click "Install" to begin the installation procedure.

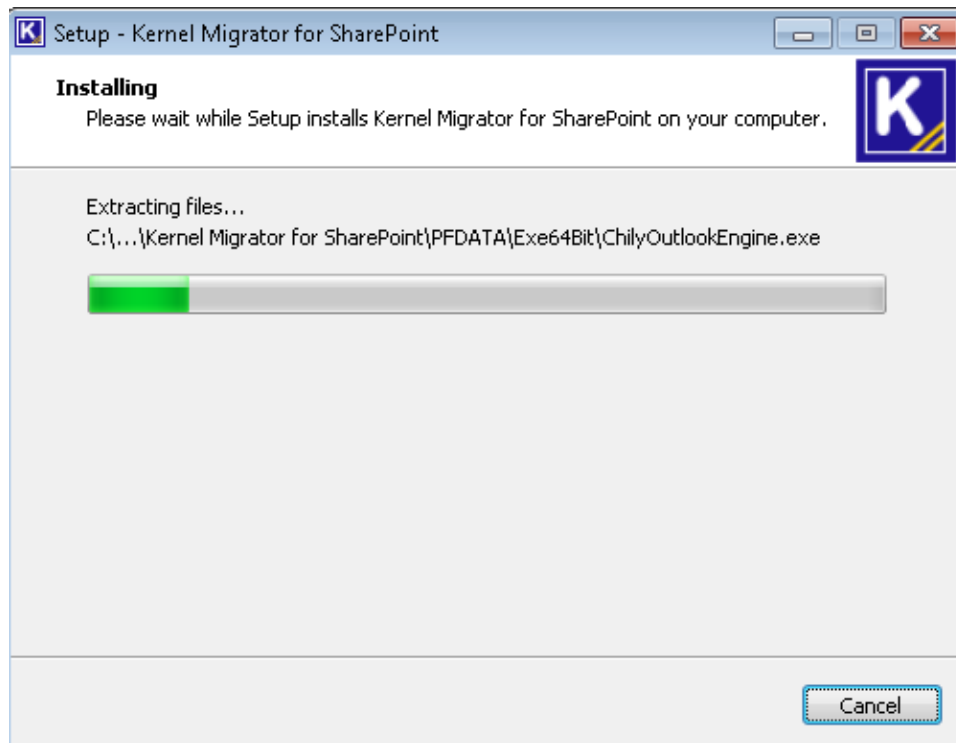


Figure 7: Software is being installed

14. When the installation process is completed successfully, the user receives the following message.

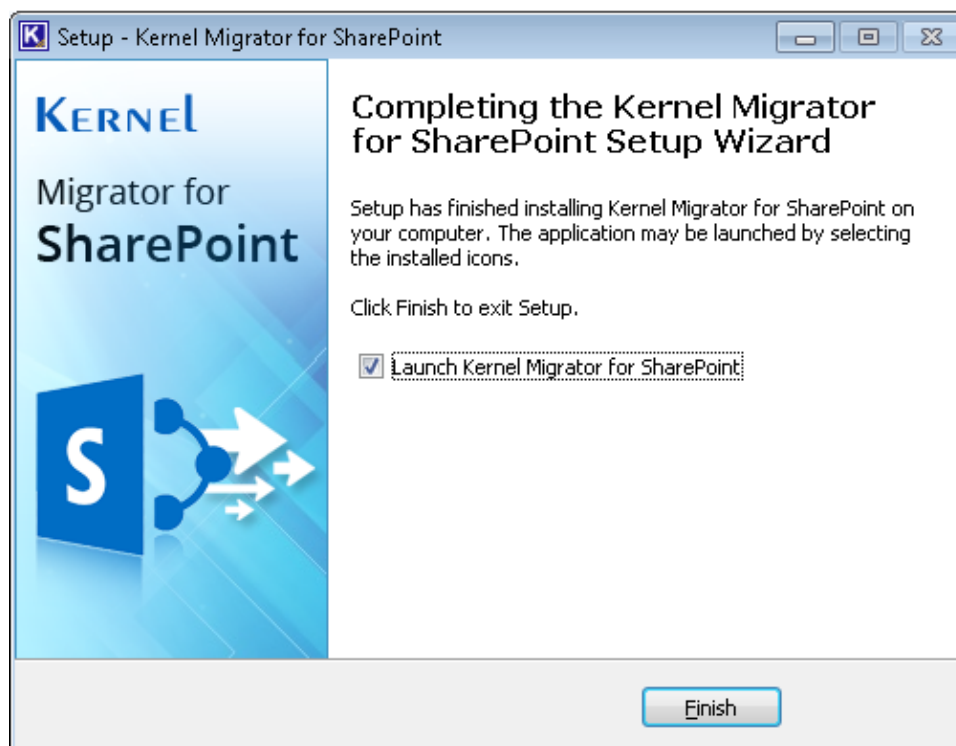


Figure 8: Software is installed

15. Click “Finish” to complete the process. It will launch the software, if you have kept the option "Launch Kernel Migrator for SharePoint" checked.

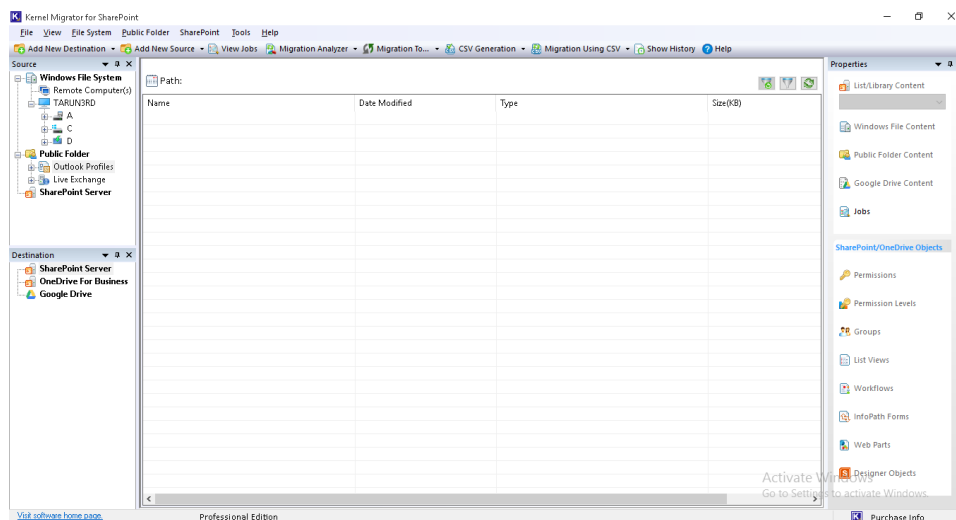


Figure 9: Welcome Screen

4. Uninstall Kernel Migrator for SharePoint

There can be a situation when you need to uninstall Kernel Migrator for SharePoint. Please make sure to close the software before uninstalling it. Follow the steps below to uninstall it.

1. There are two ways to start the uninstallation.
 - a. Go to **Start** → **"All Programs"** → **"Kernel Migrator for SharePoint"**, click **"Uninstall Kernel Migrator for SharePoint"**.
 - b. Click **Start** → **Control Panel**. Launch **"Add/Remove Programs"** or **"Programs"**. Select **"Kernel Migrator for SharePoint"** and click **"Remove"**.
2. Following any of the above methods displays a warning message.

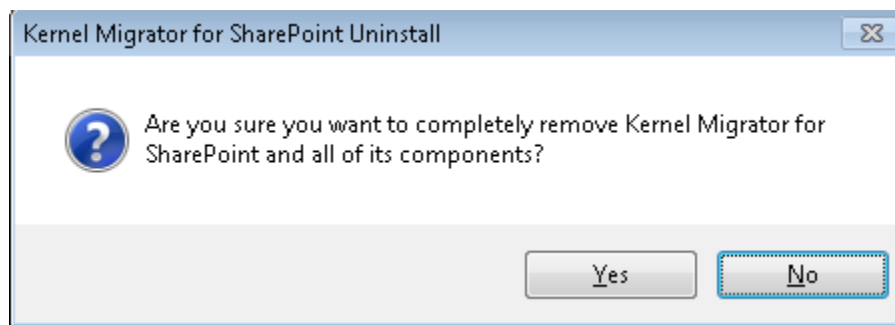


Figure 10: Warning to uninstall the software

3. Click **"Yes"** to uninstall the software.
4. If a scheduled migration job is running while uninstalling the software, you will receive the following warning.

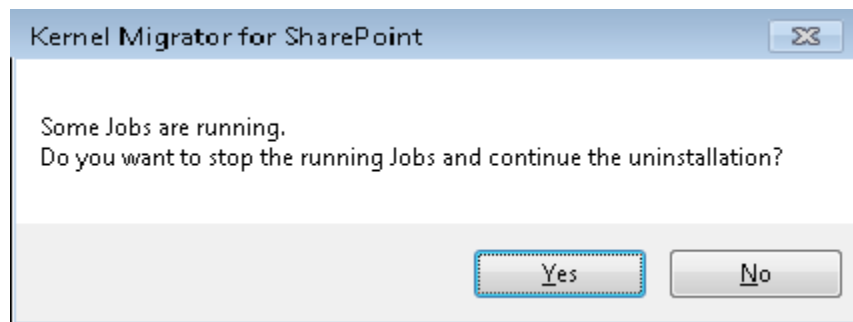


Figure 11: Warning to stop the running job

5. Click **"Yes"** to stop the job and to uninstall the software.

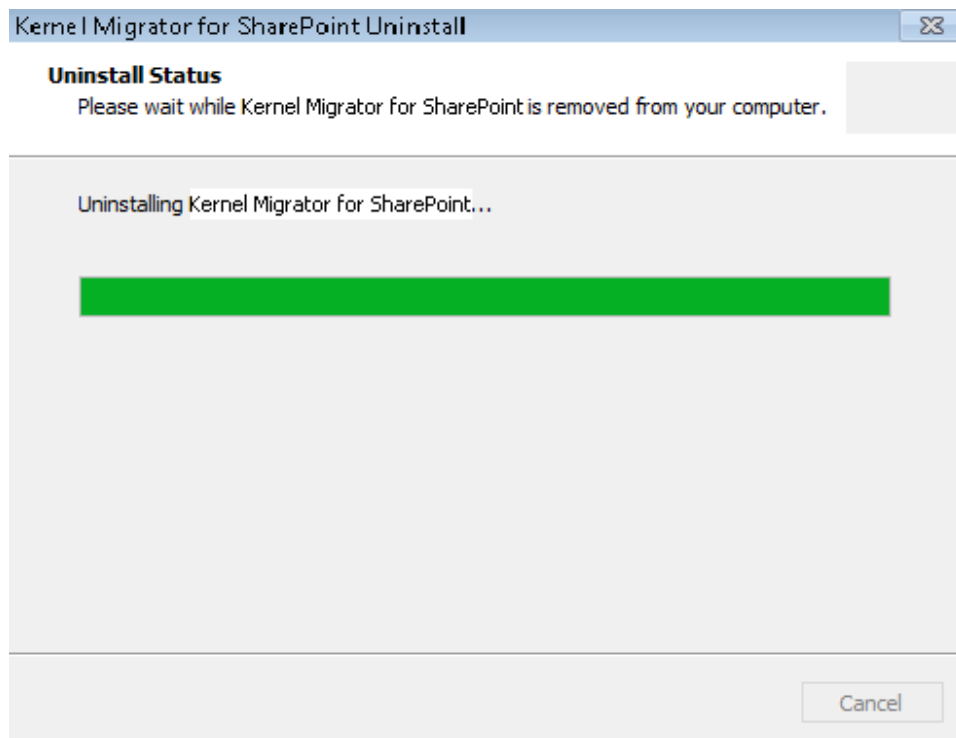


Figure 12: Uninstalling the software

- When the software is removed, the following message box appears onscreen.

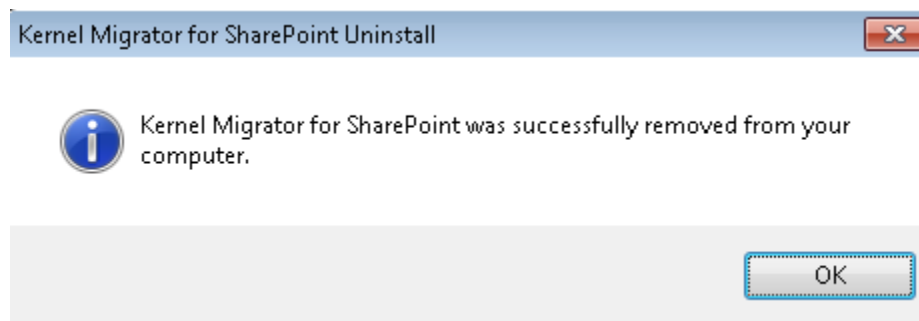


Figure 13: The software is finally uninstalled.

- Click “OK” to finish the process.

After following the above steps, Kernel Migrator for SharePoint will be uninstalled successfully from your computer system.

By default, the software is configured to retain the license file, behavioral data to handle source and destinations, and other settings in the program installation folder.

To remove the remaining elements, delete its program installation folder manually and then empty the Recycle Bin as well. Kindly do not remove this folder if you want to retain the license file and/or have to reinstall the same/upgraded version of the software. The default path of the program installation folder is **%ProgramFiles%\Kernel Migrator for SharePoint** – for both 32-bit and 64-bit OS.

5. Activating the License

5.1: Types of Licenses

KernelApps Pvt. Ltd. offers the following types of license for Kernel Migrator for SharePoint.

You have to buy the separate licenses for File Server to SharePoint Migration, Public Folder (of Exchange Server) to SharePoint Migration, and SharePoint to SharePoint Migration.

- **Trial Version:** The trial edition of the product will remain active only for 30 days.

Following are the limitations of trial version.

- You can upload only five items per migration from File Server or Public Folders to the SharePoint.
- Here are the restrictions for SharePoint to SharePoint.
 - ☑ Only five items will be migrated per migration.
 - ☑ Only five lists or libraries each containing five items only will be migrated per migration.
 - ☑ Subsites will not be migrated while migrating a site.
- You can download only five items per job from the SharePoint.

After the expiry of these tries or 30 days trial period, you have to upgrade to either Perpetual or Subscription license for uninterrupted usage.

- **Subscription License:** The product will remain active only for the subscribed period. The license has to be renewed thereafter.
- **Perpetual License:** The product will remain active for a lifetime. There is no time limitation.

5.2 Generate License Request File

You need to follow the below-mentioned steps for generating a license request file.

1. Go to the "Help" Menu and click "Generate License Code" option.

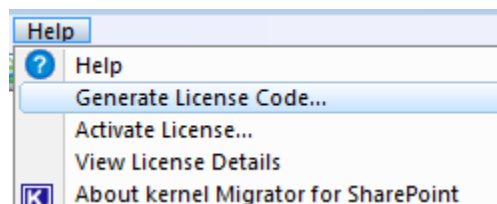


Figure 14: Generate License Code option

2. Doing this shows the following dialogue box.

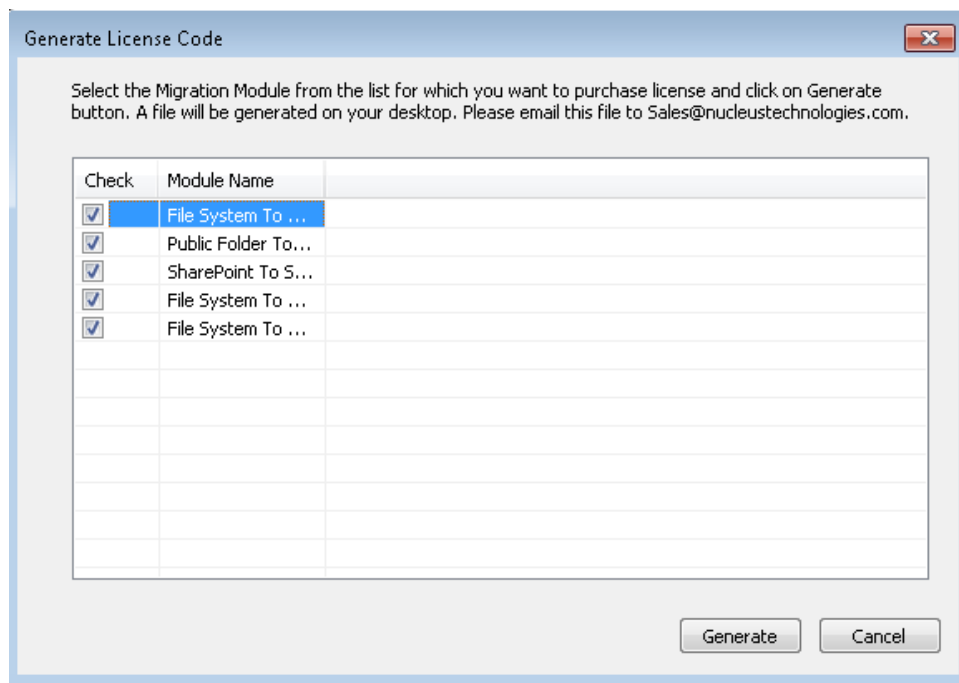


Figure 15: "Generate License Code" box

3. It displays the available modules of the software such as
 - File System to SharePoint Migration
 - Public Folder to SharePoint Migration
 - SharePoint to SharePoint Migration
4. Select the modules for which you want to obtain the license.
5. Click **Generate** button to generate the license request file. Once the file is generated, the following message is displayed to confirm the generation of the license request file.

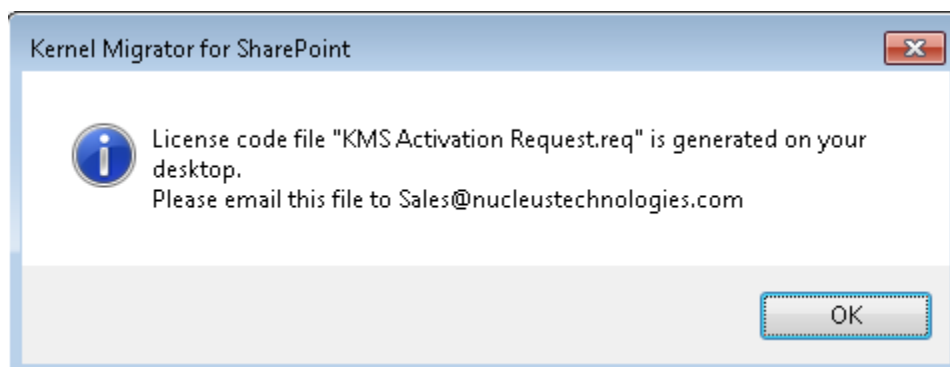


Figure 16: Message box to inform the generation of the License Request file

6. Click "OK". A file named "LMD Activation Request.req" is generated and stored on the desktop of the current logged on user.
7. Send this file through email to sales@nucleustechnologies.com along with the type of license you need. The Free Trial version of the software is available for the first time users for 30 days. You have to upgrade the license to Professional Edition after the expiration of this trial period.
8. Our Sales Team will revert very soon with a License file. Store that file on the disk.

5.3 Applying the License

Follow the steps below to apply the received license.

1. Go to the "Help" menu and click "Activate License" option.

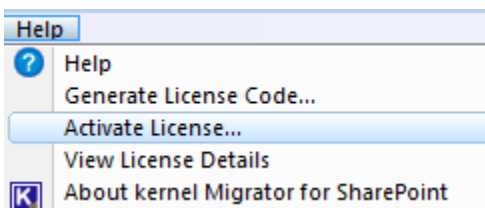


Figure 17: "Activate License" box

2. Clicking this option shows the following dialogue box.

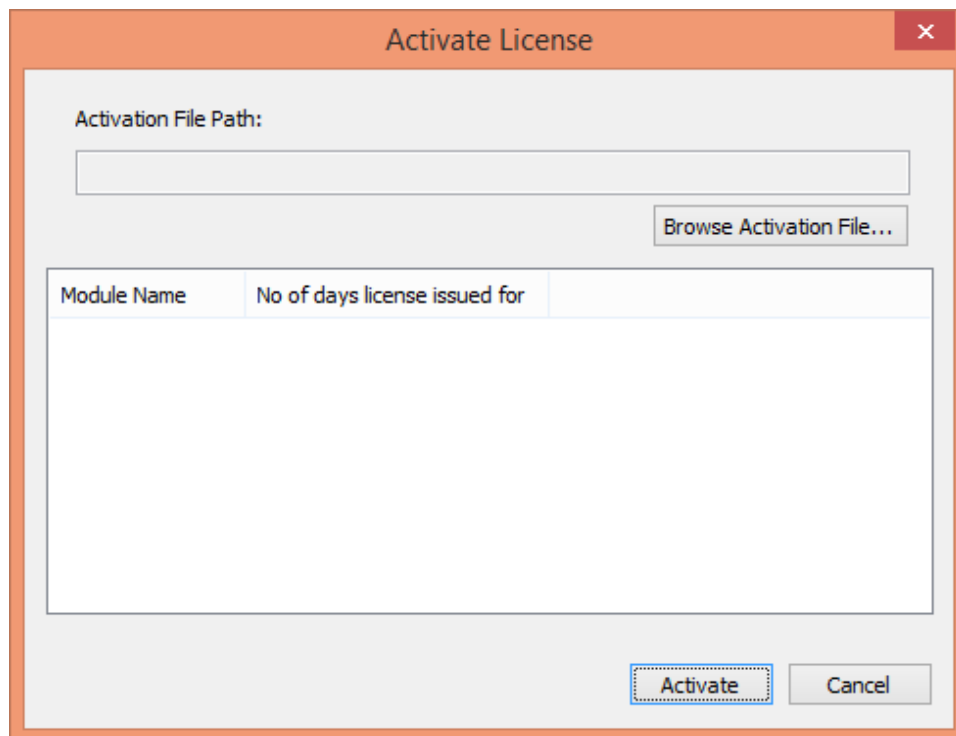



Figure 18: "Activate License" box

3. Click  button to browse the received activation file with the following box.

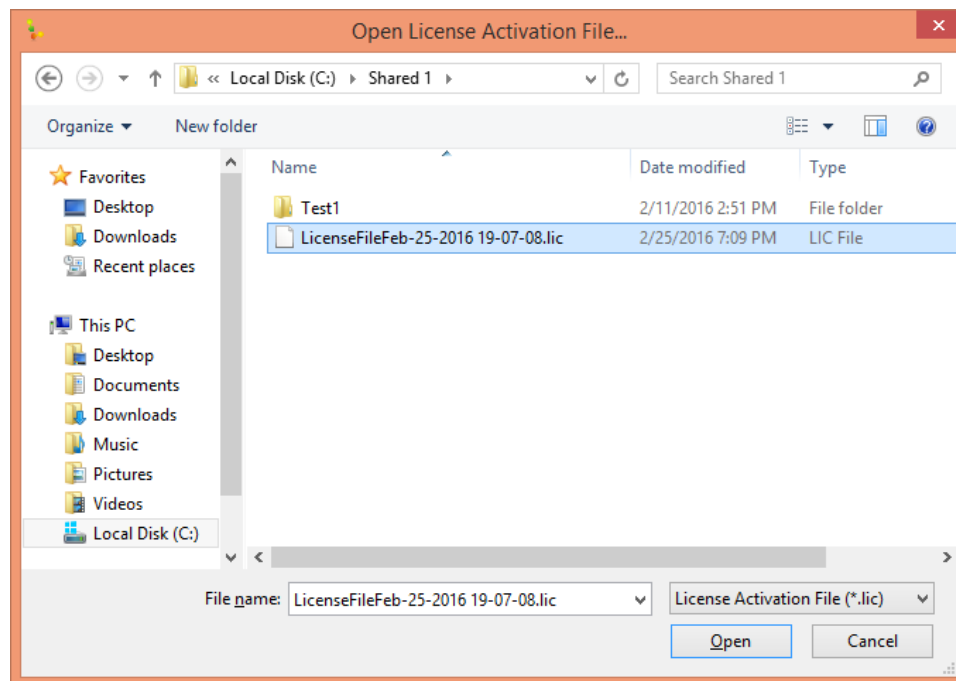


Figure 19: "Open License File" box

4. Select the location where the license activation file is stored.
5. Select the license activation file and click "Open" button. It takes you back to the previous box, which displays the added license activation file.

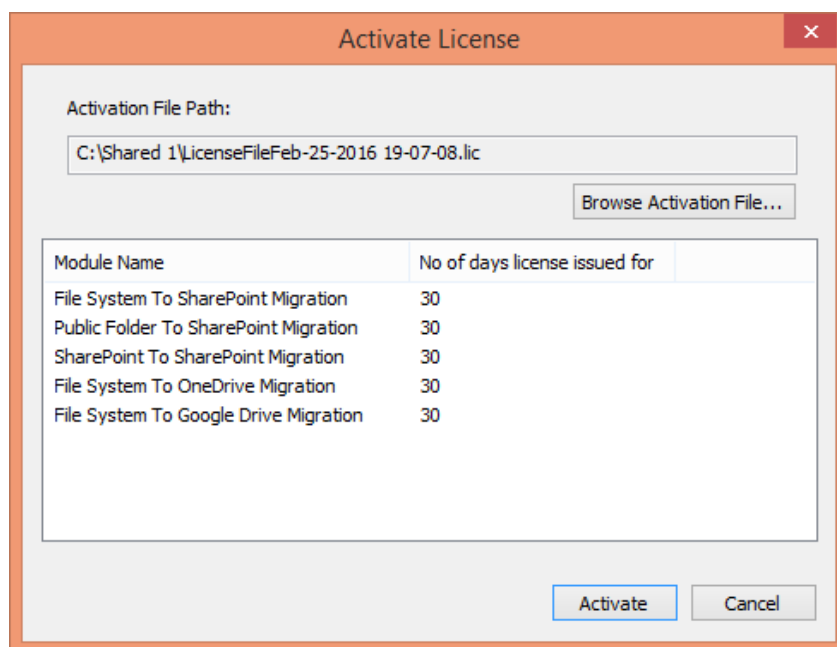


Figure 20: "Activate License" box now shows the selected file.

6. The dialog box shows the licensed modules and their activation period.

- Click  button to apply the license to the software.

Follow the steps below to view the details of the applied license in the software.

- Go to the "Help" menu and click "View License Details" option.

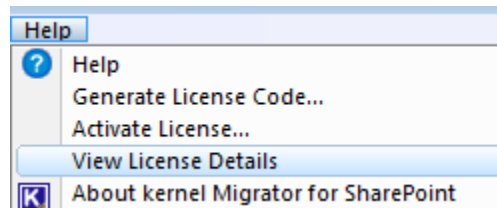


Figure 21: "View License Details" Option

- Doing this displays the following dialogue box.

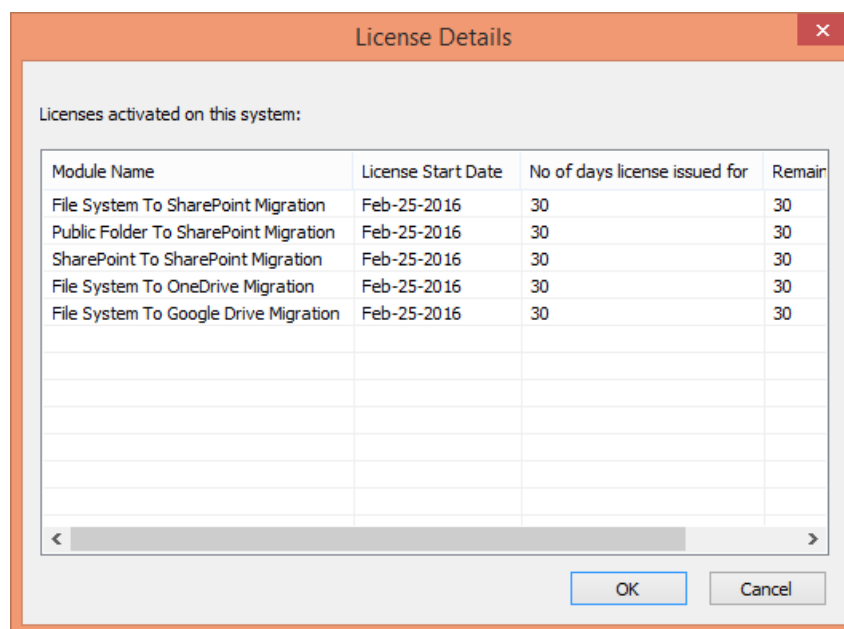


Figure 22: "License Details" box
