In Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook 17.0

This document describes the latest enhancements to Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook

Introduction

Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook is a user-friendly tool to migrate Notes mailbox items to MS Outlook effortlessly. It saves NSF/Domino Server files to PST or Exchange Server, and makes emails, contacts, calendar, and other mailbox items accessible in MS Outlook and Exchange. This tool migrates each and every item with total accuracy and integrity.

Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook operates in two modes—Standard Mode and Advanced Mode. In Advanced Mode, users can migrate NSF files in batch with the help of a CSV file.

The latest version, Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook 17.0, makes Notes to Outlook migration even more easier with its newly introduced features and enhanced performance.

Latest Enhancements

Kernel for Lotus Notes to Outlook Version 17.0 has the following updates:

- Introduces a 'PST split' feature to save NSF data in multiple PST files of desired size.
- More powerful feature to include or exclude specific Item Types in migration.
- More robust feature to exclude selected mailbox folders from migration.
- More efficient batch migration (migration of many NSF files at a time using CSV file)
- Support for Exchange Server 2016, MS Outlook 2016, and Lotus Notes 9.0 versions

These new features improve the efficiency and accuracy of NSF to Outlook migration.
